Decision making & Accountability as Leaders in Making ...

1. Own Every Choice, Good or Bad: Leadership begins with owning your own decisions—whether those choices lead to success or mistakes. Accountability means not blaming others when things go wrong and learning from every outcome.

2. Think Before You Act, Not After: Pause and evaluate the consequences YOUR decisions on peers, teachers, and the school's reputation. Impulsive choices may feel **easy**, but responsible ones build trust.

3. Badge Represents Duty, Not Power: Badge symbol of service and responsibility, not authority to command. Every decision should be guided by fairness, integrity, and the school's values.

4. Be the First to Own Failures, the Last to Claim Credit: True accountability means stepping forward when a team fails and stepping back when a team succeeds.
