Karthik participated in District, State, National level tournaments and brought glory and fame to his parents and school.

- ⌘ Karthik represented Lake Montfort School and secured the 1st place in DCA State Level Inter School Tournament. He was unbeaten with a score of 7/7.
- ⌘ He stood 1st in Under 9 Category in BRDCA (Bangalore Rural District Chess Association) Online Tournament.
- ⌘ He secured the 3rd Place in Under – 1200 Category in Bishan Singh Fide Rated Tournament held in Hyderabad between 10th to 14th January 2023 and won the cash prize of Rs. 15000.
- ⌘ Karthik was the champion in Karnataka and stood All India 11th in Under 9 Category at MPL 11th National Schools Chess Championship.
- ⌘ He got the 4th place in Under – 10 Category in Karnataka State Amateur Championship.
- ⌘ He secured the 1st place in Under - 09 Open Category in HSM Memorial Rapid Chess Tournament.
- ⌘ He got the International Fide Rating in all the Formats Rapid, Classical and Blitz.
- ⌘ He is the winner of Bangalore Rural District Championship.
- ⌘ He participated in many local, Fide and Online tournaments and bagged 53 trophies.
- ⌘ He achieved the title Arena Candidate Master at the age of eight. ■
