



Saint Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort

St. Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort was born on 31st January 1673 in the small town of MONTFORT in western France. Even from his childhood days he was virtuous and demonstrated an extraordinary love for the poor. He admired and loved Mary the most saintly mother of Jesus Christ.

He became a priest and worked ceaselessly for God and went about from place to place with the message of God's love for humankind. He served the poor people and championed their cause. He was a great scholar, powerful speaker and author of many spiritual works, such as 'The Love of Eternal Wisdom' and 'True Devotion to Mary'.

His capacity to paint and carve, along with his literary and poetic skills, has made him a spiritual "Leonardo da Vinci".

He never bothered about the consequences of telling the 'truth' and doing what was right in the eyes of God. He was victimized by the world for his honesty, conviction and outspokenness.

He died at the early age of 43 on 28 April 1716. He was acclaimed a Saint by the people and the Church. He established three dedicated groups of men and women to carry on his good works, particularly the education of the young. One such organization is that of the Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel.





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Infra**structure**

- Class Rooms: The school has 3 major divisions—the KG Block, Primary Block and Secondary & Senior Secondary Block. The KG block has grades from Pre-KG to UKG where the tiny tots are given an opportunity to develop their intellectual and psycho motor skills by using the play way method and making learning a fun oriented activity. The Primary Block accommodates Grade 1 to 5, while Secondary & Senior Secondary Block has Grade 6 to 12. All the class rooms from Pre-KG to Grade 12 have smart boards with content provided by TATA Classedge. All the class rooms have CCTV camera integrated with Public Address System.
- Kids Fun Station: The KG block has a Kids Fun Station (KFS) for the children to play during Physical Education Period and during breaks.

- * School Library: An extensive and spacious library provides ample opportunities for the students to cultivate a habit of reading. A separate library period is also allotted in their time table. Students are encouraged to make use of this facility.
- Laboratories: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and Computer Science labs are well equipped for practical work. There are separate computer labs for Primary & Senior Secondary Blocks.
- Multimedia: There is a spacious and well equipped room set apart for this purpose. We always keep pace with technology and make teaching – learning process easier and interesting for students, so that they become more proficient in mastering the academic subjects.



















- Music: All classes have a period for music and singing on a regular basis. We have well trained music teachers and a school band. Special coaching is provided for instrumental and vocal music.
- Dance: All classes have a period for dance and special coaching is provided for Indian classical dances like Bharatanatyam, Folk and Western dance.
- Art & Craft: Classes are conducted on a regular basis to bring out the students' innate skills and aesthetic talents. They take part in various competitions throughout the year.
- Sports & Games: For the overall development of the students, various sports activities are conducted. We have well trained staff to conduct the different disciplines in an innovative way. A well-equipped gymnasium facilitates the students to keep them fit. Well laid play fields provide various opportunities to learn

- Basket Ball, Foot Ball, Volley Ball, Kho-kho and Cricket. "Sports Day" is an Annual Event and it usually wins big acclaim from all the spectators. Students take part in District, State and National Level Competitions.
- Counselling Center: There is a well set up counselling center with a trained full time counsellor to help students to deal with their personal, social and academic problems as well as to provide career guidance.
- Chapel: LMS has a chapel that can seat about 150 students, where weekly Holy Mass is celebrated.
- Auditorium: Our mini-auditorium is used for various school functions, PTM etc.

The assessment structure and examination for Grade 1 to 8 comprises of two terms, i.e., Term-I and Term-II.

The Term-I consists of two Periodic Assessments and a Half yearly Examination.

The Term-II consists of two Periodic Assessments and an Annual Examination.

The progress of the students of Grade 9 & 10 is assessed by record of 3 periodic tests carrying 50 marks each in the form of Pre- Mid-term, Mid-term & Post Midterm.

The Annual Examination is conducted for 80 marks comprising the entire portion.

- The progress of the students of Grade 11 & 12 is assessed through UT, MT, Cyclic Test and Preparatory Examination.
- Competitive Exams: Apart from the regular assessment, students also take competitive exams such as Montfort International Olympiad, IEO, IMO, NSO, DCL, National Talent Search AIMS Exams, Sarvodaya Scholarship Exam etc. and win various prizes.

Procedure for **Admission**

Normally, admission is given for Pre-KG & LKG. However, depending on the availability of seats, admissions to other grades also may be made. The prospectus and application form will be issued from the first week of November and made valid only for that particular academic year.

Eligibility for admission to the Senior Secondary Class

- A pass in Grade 10 Examination
- The candidate MUST meet all the conditions set by the Board
- Entrance Test

Documents to be submitted

- Photocopy of the SSLC/AISSE or equivalent Marks Card
- Original TC from the school last attended with DISE code & STS number
- Copy of Category Certificate (...if applicable)
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Aadhar Card of both Parents & Student
- One recent passport-size photograph of the applicant affix on the application form
- Blood Group

THE PROSPECTUS AND REGISTRATION FORM

will be issued from the first week of November and made valid only for that particular academic year.



Registration Particulars

- Registration for admission must be made on the prescribed form issued along with the prospectus.
- The application form is valid only for a week from the date of issue. The form is not transferable.
- Filled in application forms for admission must reach the school office within seven days from the date of issue.
- 4. All students seeking admission must enclose Photostat copies of the birth certificate.
 - A student seeking admission to Pre KG should have completed 3 years by 31st May
 - A student seeking admission to LKG should have completed 4 years by 31st May
 - A student seeking admission to UKG should have completed 5 years by 31st May
 - Copy of statement of marks of progress in class from the previous school must be submitted.
 - Other certificates of co-curricular activities, if any are also to be produced.

- Application forms which do not give the necessary information will not be accepted.
- 6. Students seeking admission may be required to appear for an entrance test in Mathematics, Science and English on a specified date.
- 7. At the time of admission the following original certificates must be submitted without fail:
 - Originals of all the certificates mentioned on page no. 18
 - Transfer certificate from the school last attended (TC and mark sheets of students from outside the state should be countersigned by the Educational officer of the area concerned)
 - Conduct certificate, statement of marks.
- 8. Failure to submit one or more of the above mentioned certificates may result in deferment.
- If discrepancies are found in the certificates, admission will be cancelled.

CANDIDATES WILL BE ENROLLED ON PAYMENT OF THE FEES, WHICH ONCE PAID WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

PLEASE NOTE:

Admission is always subject to the Board's approval.

The application form (correctly and neatly filled) should reach the school office within a week.

No Recommendations Will Be Entertained for **Admission**

PLEASE NOTE:

- ^{1.} Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- 2. 95% attendance is compulsory for all students from Pre KG to Grade 12
- 3. Students are advised not to bring any valuables, such as gold chains, cameras, mobile phones, recorders, costly watches, or any other articles of value to the school. The school authorities will not be responsible for the loss/ damage of such personal belongings.
- Damage done to school property, buildings, furniture, window panes, lights, library books, sports equipment and goods, buses and laboratory equipment will entail a fine.
- 5. Uniform prescribed must be strictly followed.
- 6. Transport facility is the responsibility of the parents. No school bus facility for the students.

- 7. CHANGE OF GRADE & SECTION is not permitted once a particular section is alloted at the time of admission.
- 8. The school will meet only the parents concerned, or guardians duly authorized by parents of the student. No other person will be entertained at any time.
- Parents are expected to co-operate with the school in all aspects for the benefit of the students and the welfare of the institution. This will help the authorities to bring out the best in every child.
- Parents are expected to look into the overall performance and holistic development of the child, rather than limiting their concern only to marks received in the exams.


